## Emergency Medical Technician Training

This is the next step up from the full First Aid at Work three day qualification (FAW). It is the qualification that most companies in the private ambulance sector will require from a recruit. The course is also suited to those working in remote areas that may need to manage a casualty longer than is normal until the emergency services arrive on the scene. The course is designed to build upon the basic skills acquired on the FAW course. Ideally a delegate considering this course would possess some experience as a first aider and will have completed at least one requalification, and therefore will have been a first aider for at least three years. The course includes airway management, including the use of airway adjuncts and suction, oxygen administration, automated external defibrillation (AED), use of basic splints, taking and recording basic observations and the management of medical emergencies. The delegates will also take part in scenarios to build up confidence in the use of skills learnt throughout the course. On completion of the course all delegates will be individually assessed.
